## After Hurricane “To Do” List

The Sterling Villages would like to hope that everyone is returning to their homes safe and everything is great with no damage. We understand that doesn't always happen. Please review our “To Do” list and let us know if there is anything we can do to make this time easier for you.

### Resident “To Do” List

- **Returning to the Property:** Prior to returning to the property, residents should obtain the “go ahead” from local authorities and the association. Once it is safe to return to the property, the association should inform residents via email or the community's website.
- **Proceed with Caution:** Returning to a damaged property can be dangerous. Local government generally provides guidance on things to consider when returning after a storm in their hurricane guides. The Red Cross also puts out a comprehensive guide on this subject
- **Window Boards/ Hurricane Shutters:** In situations where window glass is not broken, remove window boards and lift hurricane shutters.
- **Damage:** Please report any roof leaks or damage to outside of building that you might find or see.

### Association “To Do” List

- **Cleanup:** Your associations has immediately contacted their preferred vendors to begin cleanup and obtain bids for repairs. Your landscaping company has started cleanup to remove plant debris from the community. Please take notice of piles of debris
- **Tree Removal:** Tree removal will start Wednesday Sep 13, 2017, please remove cars from the area where trees are down to make room for the trucks.
- **Gates:** Gate tracks will be observed for damage and if everything is cleared and working properly, gates will be closed again by Wednesday Sep 13, 2017.
- **Pool Area:** Pool will be cleaned and safe to enter by Wednesday Sep 13, 2017
